Time of Incident: 49:30, EL 154, Sport Club Csíkszereda - Gyergyói Hoki Klub playoff match 3

Players Involved: #45 GYHK Ravasz Csanád
#20 SCCS Becze Tihamér

Call on the Ice: There was no call made on the play being reviewed.

The Head of the Referee's Working Group requested an investigation for the play. The records have not shown an injury.

IIHF RULE 52 Slew Foot

1. "Slew-footing" is the act of a Player using their leg or foot to knock or kick an opponent's feet from under them or pushes an opponent's upper body backward with an arm or elbow, and at the same time with a forward motion of their leg, knocks or kicks the opponent's feet from under them, causing them to fall violently to the ice.
2. The Referee shall, at their discretion, assess a major penalty and an automatic game misconduct penalty if a Player is guilty of "slew-footing" on an opposing Player
3. If the action is minimal or the opponent is not violently thrown to the ice, the Referees may choose to use rules 51 Roughing or 57 Tripping to address this action.

IIHF RULE 52.3 DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

If deemed appropriate, Supplementary Discipline can be applied by the Proper Authorities at their discretion.

Review of Incident:

At 10:25 of the 3rd period, SCCS #20 Becze Tihamér was carrying the puck into the attacking zone along the boards on the left side of the ice. GYHK # 45 Ravasz Csanád is defending him. Ravasz Csanád then places his left leg behind BECZE TIHAMÉR and pushes with his left arm causing Becze Tihamér to fall backwards landing on his left hip.



The Committee Ruling:

- The Committee **determined that the action technically satisfied the rulebook definition for a major penalty plus a game misconduct for slew footing** and penalty for slew footing should have been called.
- The play met the criteria, and these plays often can be dangerous, but in this case, the fall was not assessed as dangerous as he landed on his hip and not on his shoulder, neck or head area.

As a result, the Committee ruled the incident as Careless Category (0-3) and do to the above explanation **Ravasz Csanád will not be suspended for the infraction.**
