The Disciplinary Committee no.2018-19/011 decree

The Disciplinary Committee investigated the Erste Liga game EL 59 (FTC-Telekom – Corona Brasov) where in the 20th minutes Garrett Clarke (Corona Brasov) penalized to 2+10+20 minutes.

In the 20th minutes of the game the player criticized the referee's activity in unsportsmanlike tone. He don't finish it when the referee warned him for several times.

IIHF RULE 168 – UNSPORTSMANLIKE

DEFINITION: A player or team official who commits a violation of the rules pertaining to sportsmanship, fair play, and respect.

Minor Penalty - An identifiable player who commits a violation of the rules of sportsmanship, fair play, and respect.

Misconduct Penalty - If a violation is flagrant or if a player continues his unsportsmanlike conduct.

Game-Misconduct Penalty - A player or team official who uses obscene, profane, or abusive language or actions directed to any person on the ice or anywhere in the rink for which he has already been assessed a minor or bench-minor penalty.

According to the Disciplinary Committee's opinion, the player behaved unsportsmanlike against the referee.

The Disciplinary Committee approve the referee's judgement, and do not use other sanctions.

The Disciplinary Committee of the Erste Liga determine that, during the championship for Garrett Clarke player of the Corona Brasov second time was imposed Game Misconduct (GAMI) penalty.

IIHF rule book RULE 109 - DURATION OF PENALTIES - GAME MISCONDUCT

A player who receives two game-misconduct penalties in the same game or different games of a tournament or event is automatically suspended for one further game.

Garrett Clarke will skip the next match of his team.

The player will spend down his sentence at the next Erste Liga game.
