The Disciplinary Committee no.2018-19/023 decree

The Disciplinary Committee investigated the Erste Liga game EL 150 (UTE – Sport Club Csíkszereda) where in the 25th minutes Róbert Egyed (Sport Club Csíkszereda) penalized 5+20 minutes for butt-ending.

IIHF RULE 121 – BUTT-ENDING

DEFINITION: A player who slides the top hand on his stick down the shaft to create a dangerous protrusion which he drives into the body of an opponent.

A player who butt-ends an opponent will be assessed either a major and automatic game-misconduct penalty or a match penalty.

The Committee made the following conclusions:

The player of the Sport Club Csíkszereda at the 25th minute of the game, at a face-off pierced the opponent player with the end of his stick. The movement was apparently intentional and conscious, directed only to cause injury.

The Disciplinary Committee pays emphasized attention to protect the physical safety of players, therefore it examines emphasizedly and punishes for dissuasive penalty the behaviour that directed only to cause injury.

The Disciplinary Committee prohibited Róbert Egyed, player of Sport Club Csíkszereda to 1 game.

The player will spend down his sentence at the next Erste Liga game.
