



ERSTE LIGA DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

The Disciplinary Committee no.2018-19/035 decree

The Disciplinary Committee investigated the Erste Liga game EL 195 (FTC-Telekom – Corona Brasov) where in the 54th minutes Sergei Peretiagin (Corona Brasov) penalized 25 minutes Match Penalty for abuse of officials.

IIHF RULE 116 – ABUSE OF OFFICIALS

DEFINITION: An attempt by a player or team official to usurp the power of an on-ice official, demean or degrade an on-ice official, call into question the integrity or ability of an on-ice official, or physically confront an on-ice official.

According to the Referees' Report, the player of Corona Brasov, Sergei Peretiagin did not obey the referee's call, when the referee called him to take the penalty box, then spat toward the referees and threatened them continuously.

The Committee made the following conclusions:

The Corona Brasov's player in a situation out of game, has committed three different irregularities, each of which has to be penalized for Match Penalty. The player did not go to the penalty box after a minor penalty, and he pushed the linesman. After that he spat toward the referee, while he was continuously shouted in an unsportsmanlike tone. Even after he left the ice, he didn't finish his unsportsmanlike behaviour, he threatened continuously the game's referees.

According to the Disciplinary Committee's ascertainment, the behaviour of Peretiagin Sergei is not compatible with hockey and Erste Liga values. Unsportsmanlike and threatening actions against the officials of the game is harmful for all participants of the sport.

The Disciplinary Committee prohibited Sergei Peretiagin player of Corona Brasov to 4 games.

The player will spend down his sentence at the next Erste Liga games.
