



Erste Liga Disciplinary Committee no.2021-22/010 decree

The Disciplinary Committee of the Erste Liga for the request of the Chairman of the Disciplinary Committee, investigated the irregularity at the Erste Liga EL 21 (FTC-Telekom - UTE) game, where at the 45th minutes Dániel Kóger (FTC-Telekom) was penalized for 2 minutes for illegal check the head and neck.

IIHF RULE 48 ILLEGAL CHECK TO THE HEAD OR NECK

There is no clean check to the head or neck. The Player delivering the hit must avoid hitting the opponent's head or neck. A hit resulting in contact with an opponent's head where the head was the main point of contact and such contact to the head was avoidable is not permitted. This rule supersedes all similar actions regarding hits to the head and neck.

The Committee made the following conclusions:

At the 45th minutes of the game Dániel Kóger collided irregularly with the opponent player.

Dániel Kóger collided with the player, who hasn't already possessed the puck. Raising his elbow during the collision, he hit his opponent directly on the head. The movement was unsportsmanlike and dangerous for injury.

The Disciplinary Committee draws attention to the fact that, according to the rules, the attack on the head and neck is one of the most serious irregularities.

The Disciplinary Committee prohibits Dániel Kóger, player of the FTC-Telekom for 1 Erste Liga game due to an irregularity that could cause injury.

The player will spend down his sentence at the next Erste Liga game.

According the Erste Liga Competition Rules 72/B. § (1) the prohibition imposed an automatic fine on the FTC-Telekom. The club must pay a fine of EUR 100 according the 72/B. § (2).
